2.	Original passport and 1 passport copy Note: The passport and the resident permit must be valid at least 3 months longer than the intended date of return from Spain. The passport must contain the signature or the fingerprint Of the holder		
3.	1 recent passport photographs Note: Passport size with white color background; must be recent (not older than 6 months); must be without head covering for male applicants		
4.	Documents proving the purpose of travel and sufficient economic proof for the period of stay		
5.	Valid visa of the country of final destination		
6.	Flight ticket showing final destination		

Please note:

- The visa must be applied for in person
- All documentation must be submitted in English or Spanish language
- For children registered in a parent's passport, a separate application form has to be submitted.
- Original documents must be presented; additional photocopies may be required
